HOW TO USE YOUR SUBMISSION TRACKER

- 1. Title of Work: Your story's title.
- 2. Publication/Market: The publication you submitted to.
- **3. Sim Subs Okay?**: Some publications accept simultaneous submissions if you alert them when your submission is accepted elsewhere. Your submission tracker will help you know which publications to contact if/when that happens.
- 4. Date Sent: The date you submitted your story.
- **5. Expect Reply By**: The publication's website or submission guidelines often state how long it takes them to reply to a submission. Record the date here, so you know when to follow up.
- 6. Followed Up On: Keep track of the dates you checked in with the publication about your story. Make sure you wait until after the Expect Reply By date before your first follow-up.
- 7. Outcome: Accepted? Rejected? Did they offer feedback?
- 8. Date of Reply: The date the publication accepted/rejected.
- 9. Notes: Anything of note about the process or publication.
